

## Grievance Appeal Process

You have the right to appeal this decision to the membership outlined in the Constitution of the UAW International Union, Article 33 (“APPEALS”) and UAW Local 578 By-Laws, Article 16 (“APPEAL PROCEDURE”), as stated below.

- Section 1. Any member dissatisfied with a decision of the Local Union or any of its representatives may appeal such decision to the membership.
- Section 2. The appeal shall be made within sixty (60) days or the next regular membership meeting, whichever is longer.
- Section 3. The appeal must be submitted in writing to the Local Union’s Recording Secretary not later than fifteen (15) days before such appeal to the Union’s membership.
- Section 4. Any appeal of the membership’s action to the International Union shall be in accordance with the International Constitution.
